



Working around live traffic

Objective

To prevent fatalities, eliminate or minimise the risk of injuries and incidents from working around live traffic.

Requirements

At Haslin Constructions:

1. We conduct and document risk assessments to identify and eliminate reasonably foreseeable hazards associated with the interaction of people, vehicles, rolling stock and site traffic.
2. We manage the risks to people through appropriate planning, communication, monitoring and review in accordance with approved traffic management plans.
3. We demarcate and provide pedestrian walkways and crossings to separate mobile plant and vehicle movement from people. If there is a (public) road or railway adjacent to the work area, we implement control measures in coordination with local authorities.
4. We provide information and instructions on designated safe routes, parking areas, pedestrian exclusion zones and speed limits for workers and visitors.
5. We develop and implement a framework to ensure workers involved in the design, inspection, modification and supervision of traffic management plans are competent and qualified.
6. Before any work starts, we apply appropriate permit, permission and approval processes to validate the risks related to working around traffic are controlled.
7. We ensure persons approving, authorising or supervising and carrying out work are competent and trained in relevant work procedures.
